

Clearways on Third Avenue and Sunnyholt Road, Blacktown to Stanhope Gardens


The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its \$121 million Clearways Program, which aims to reduce congestion and delays on Sydney's roads.

Roads and Maritime Services is installing new clearways on Third Avenue and Sunnyholt Road between Richmond Road, Blacktown and Old Windsor Road, Stanhope Gardens. The new clearways will be open to traffic from **Monday 3 June 2019** and will apply '**At All Times**' including on weekdays, weekends and public holidays.

The new clearways connect to the existing 'At All Times' clearway on Old Windsor Road and will allow Roads and Maritime to respond and tow vehicles that stop illegally or breakdown along the corridor.

This corridor provides direct access to the Blacktown CBD, Kings Langley, Parklea, Stanhope Gardens and Kellyville so these clearways will have a positive impact for the road users.

The new clearway hours will apply in both directions and are shown on the map below.

The new clearways signs will be installed between Saturday 25 May and Sunday 2 June, weather permitting.

How will this affect you?

The new clearways will be open to traffic from **Monday 3 June 2019**. Clearways will allow illegally parked and broken down vehicles to be towed to ensure all lanes are available to move people and goods, helping to ease congestion, improve journey time reliability and safety.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes while the signs are installed to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller directions. What is a clearway?

A clearway is a section of road where stopping and parking is not allowed during the times shown on the clearway sign. Clearways are put on key state roads where traffic is often heavy and congested. They help keep vehicles moving by making all lanes available to road users.

To report a vehicle parked or stopped in a clearway or if your vehicle has been towed from a clearway, please call the Transport Management Centre on 131 700.
